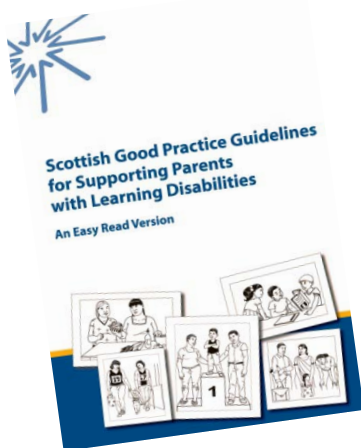
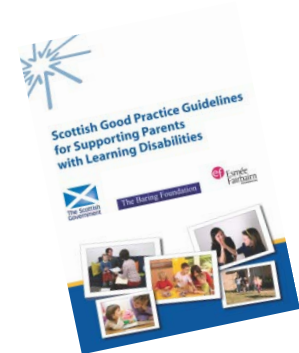


Working Together With Parents Network
