LEARNING & DEVELOPMENT SUB GROUP REPORT

1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

- 1.1 To provide the East Ayrshire Child Protection Committee (EACPC) with an update on the progress achieved by the Learning & Development Sub Group since the date of the last committee (7 September 2010)

2. PROGRESS OF TRAINING SUB GROUP

- 2.1 The Sub Group has met on one occasion since the last Child Protection Committee on Thursday 7 October 2010.
- 2.2 Work has taken place with regard to non attendance at training courses. For the period 1 April 2009 – 31 March 2010 a total of 25 courses were delivered of which, 23 were affected by non attendees on the day. Appendix 1 gives the break down of the courses and non attendance numbers by agency for the period 1 April 2009 – 31 March 2010.
- 2.3 The Learning & Development Sub Group is now chaired by Ann Marie McIntosh, Social Work Training Manager.
- 2.4 The short life working group has been established to address the need for Chronology and Record Keeping Training. The group met on 23 September 2010 and work has progressed with the development of a training pack. The group will meet again on 10 December 2010.
- 2.5 East Ayrshire Council Library Services have developed an Internet Training pack and it this will be delivered initially in January and February 2011 at the Dick Institute. Further courses will be scheduled if demand for this training continues.
- 2.6 A training matrix is currently being developed which will be used to consult with partners in relation to their agencies training requirement for 2011/12. This will then be the baseline for reporting against and the sub group will then be in a position to report percentages in relation to numbers trained and awaiting training.

3.1 The East Ayrshire Child Protection Committee is asked to: -

- i) note the progress of the training sub group;
- ii) consider the impact of non attendance at training courses
- iii) otherwise note the content of the report
