1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

- 1.1 To enable the East Ayrshire Child Protection Committee (EACPC) to consider the planned development session on 19 April 2011

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 EACPC planning and review arrangements set out two development sessions each year to enable the committee to spend time reviewing the work that has been completed and planning the key areas for future work.
- 2.2 The committee's business plan for 2008-2011 will require to have its final review. EACPC is committed to aligning its business planning arrangements to those of the Children and Young People's plan to ensure a seamless planning structure for children and young people in East Ayrshire. On this basis it is suggested that the planning session on 19 April 2011 focus on the development of the key themes for the EACPC 2011-2015 business plan.
- 2.3 Andrew MacDonald, Service Manager, Planning and Development, Social Work has agreed to assist in the development of the plan.
- 2.4 Previous development session focused on consideration of a multi agency agreement of a definition of 'outcomes' and led to the development of a outcomes guide for practitioners.
