### PROPOSED ONE WAY SYSTEM – DALVENNAN AVENUE, PATNA, EAST AYRSHIRE

#### Report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhood Services

#### 1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To seek the approval of the Cabinet for the introduction of a one way system in Dalvennan Avenue, Patna, East Ayrshire.

#### 2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Concerns have been raised by the Local Member and Community Association regarding parking and safety issues on Dalvennan Avenue. Vehicles accessing the health centre, residential and business premises park vehicles on both sides of the street resulting in conflicts with traffic.
- 2.2 Due to the narrow width of the road throughout Dalvennan Avenue it has become increasingly difficult for traffic to flow in both directions. The one way system will address the road safety concerns, reduce congestion and improve traffic flows.

#### 3. PROPOSAL

##### 3.1 One way system

It is proposed to introduce a one way system on Dalvennan Avenue in a south westerly direction from its junction with Dallowie Road to its junction with Carnshalloch Avenue; Appendix 1

#### 4. PROCEDURES

- 4.1 The draft Order has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (procedures) (Scotland) Regulations 1999.
- 4.2 **Consultation** – the organisations, representative groups and individuals consulted during the preparation of the Order are detailed in Appendix 2.
- 4.3 The Chief Constable has no objections to the draft Order.
- 4.4 No objections were received from any of the consultees.
- 4.5 Due to the passage of time the opportunity has been taken to consult with the new local Members, Councillors Sutherland and Filson, who have indicated support for the proposals.
- 4.6 **Publication of Proposals** – The draft Order was published in the Ayrshire Classified on 15<sup>th</sup> February 2007. Full details of the proposals with plans were available for inspection at:

- Roads & Transportation Office, Holmquarry Road, Kilmarnock
- Council Offices, Rigg Road, Lugar

**6.1** The promotion of the Order has been in accordance with the requirements of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1999.

### **7. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

**7.1** The associated costs in making and implementing the one way Order will be met from existing budgets.

### **8. COMMUNITY PLAN / POLICY IMPLICATIONS**

**8.1** The proposed one way Order is designed to enhance road safety for the local community in this area. The proposals will also improve the flow of traffic, reduce congestion and facilitate the safe passage for all road users.

### **9. RECOMMENDATIONS**

**9.1** It is recommended that the Cabinet:

- (i) notes the content of the report; and
- (ii) approve the making of the Order for the introduction of a one way traffic system in Dalvennan Avenue.
