1. (a) Sport

- (i) Kilmarnock Angling Club (CG 3770) – Continued for further clarification about the use, and any legal implications, of the equipment by the Crown Bailiffs and to remit further consideration of the application to the Head of Democratic Services in consultation with the Chair and Vice-Chair.

1.3 Applications Refused

(a) Young People

- (i) Silverwood Home and School Association (CG 3780) – Refused as the purchase of selection boxes was not considered to be an appropriate use of community grant funding;
- (ii) Silverwood Home and School Association (CG 3779) – Refused as the pantomime visit was within school hours and, therefore, the responsibility of the school and should not be funded through the Community Grants Scheme.

NAMING OF STREETS BY LOCAL COMMUNITY PLANNING FORUM

2.1 DEVELOPMENT AT SHORTLEES CRESCENT, KILMARNOCK

There was submitted a report dated 19 November 2007 (circulated) by the Depute Chief Executive/Executive Director of Corporate Support which requested that the Forum consider two street names for a new development at Shortlees Crescent, Kilmarnock.

It was agreed:-

- (i) to name the streets “Shortlees Court” and “Shortlees Gardens”;
- (ii) that the Executive Head of Finance and Asset Management be advised accordingly; and
- (iii) otherwise, to note the contents of the report.

2.2 DEVELOPMENT AT DUNDONALD ROAD, KILMARNOCK (item 7, page 139, 07/11)

There was submitted a report dated 26 November 2007 (circulated) by the Depute Chief Executive/Executive Director of Corporate Support regarding a street name for a new development at Dundonald Road, Kilmarnock.

It was agreed:-

- (i) to note that consultations were still taking place with the Supporters’ Groups with a ballot being organised for all supporters at the Kilmarnock Football Club’s home game with Gretna on 15 December 2007, with the result to be intimated to the Council thereafter;
- (ii) that as a result of the ballot not being available until 15 December 2007, the naming of the street be remitted to the Head of Democratic Services in consultation with the Chair and Vice-Chair of the Local Community Planning

Forum and the Local Members following receipt of the Supporters' Associations suggestion;

- (iii) that the Executive Head of Finance and Asset Management be advised accordingly; and
- (iv) otherwise, to note the contents of the report.
