NAMING OF STREETS BY LOCAL PLANNING FORUMS - DEVELOPMENT AT DUNDONALD ROAD, KILMARNOCK

1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1** The purpose of this report is to request that the Committee consider a street name for a new development at Dundonald Road, Kilmarnock.

2 BACKGROUND

- 2.1** The Decentralisation Sub Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee at its meeting on 4 June 1996 agreed that the naming of streets be included within the remit of Local Committees (now Local Community Planning Forums).
- 2.2** Section 97 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 gives authority to East Ayrshire Council in relation to naming of streets and the preparation of house numbers etc.
- 2.3** Following agreement at the Community Planning Forum at its meeting on 23 October 2007 Kilmarnock FC Supporters' Association and the Kilmarnock Supporters' Society Ltd were included as part of the consultation process in addition to the Local Community Council and the Elected Members for the Ward, as the street is within the grounds of Rugby Park.

3 CURRENT POSITION

- 3.1** The developer has asked that consideration be given to the name "Annandale Court".
- 3.2** Consultations are still taking place with the Supporters' Groups. A ballot is being organised for all supporters at the Club's home game with Gretna on 15 December, with the result to be intimated to the Council thereafter.

5 RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended:-

- (ii) that the Technical Services Section be advised accordingly; and
- (iii) otherwise to note the contents of the report.
