The grant is based on the group having 15 sessions at Rosebank starting on 3<sup>rd</sup> December and finishing on 25<sup>th</sup> March.

Part of the grant would also be used for transport to the new venue as some of the elderly members do not have access to cars and personal safety may be at risk.

By providing this grant the elderly group would be able to continue to provide a meeting place for various age groups to take part in activities. The group promotes social interaction and also prevents social isolation for elderly members.
