

2.1 Leisure

2.1.1 Howard Park Bowling Club (CG 4917) (pages 6-7) – Submit assessment by the Executive Director of Neighbourhood Services ([copy enclosed](#)).

2.1.2 Bellfield Bowling Club (CG 4910) (pages 8-9) – Submit assessment by the Executive Director of Neighbourhood Services ([copy enclosed](#)).

2.1.3 Bellfield Bowling Club (CG 4909) - The total project costs are £1783.34 with a full Community Grant of this amount sought in respect of carpeting the main hall. It should be noted that this application would be considered as revenue funding. It is a cross boundary application with 85% of the membership being from Central South. The Committee is asked whether it would wish to support in principle an award of up to £1515.84 (being the cross boundary portion) subject to receipt of a satisfactory assessment with payment of grant being delegated to the Head of Democratic Services in consultation with the Chair and Vice Chair. 2.1.4 Bellfield Bowling Club (CG 4908) - The total project costs are £760.00 with a full Community Grant of this amount sought in respect of polo shirts. It is a cross boundary application with 85% of the membership being from Central South. The Committee is asked whether it would wish to support in principle an award of up to £644.85 (being the relevant cross boundary portion) subject to receipt of a satisfactory assessment with payment of grant being delegated to the Head of Democratic Services in consultation with the Chair and Vice Chair.

2.2 Older People

2.2.1 Kilmarnock North Elderly Forum (CG 4694) (pages 10-11) – Submit assessment by the Executive Director of Educational and Social Services ([copy enclosed](#)).

2.2.2 Bentinck Elderly Social Club (CG 4952) – The total project costs are £644.00 with a community grant of £300 sought in respect of a summer outing to Oban. It is a cross boundary application with 47% of the membership being from Central South. The Committee is asked whether it would wish to support the application in principle up to £141.00 (being the relevant cross boundary portion) subject to receipt of a satisfactory assessment with payment of grant being delegated to the Head of Democratic Services in consultation with the Chair and Vice Chair.

2.2.3 Bentinck Elderly Social Club (CG 4960) - The total cost of the project is £1,733 with a community grant of £1,733 sought in respect of hall lets and taxi fares. It is a cross boundary application with 47% of the membership being from Central

South the Committee is asked whether it would wish to support the application in principle of up to £814.51 (being the relevant cross-boundary portion) subject to receipt of a satisfactory assessment with payment of the grant being delegated to the Head of Democratic Services in consultation with the Chair and Vice Chair.

2.3 Sport

2.3.1 Crosshouse Boys Club (CG 4883) (pages 12-13) – Submit updated assessment by the Executive Director of Neighbourhood Services ([copy enclosed](#)).

2.3.2 Bellfield Youth Football Club (CG 4907) – The total project costs are £10,000.00 in respect of league fees, cup fees, coaching courses, pitch hire, insurance and electricity costs. The Club are seeking a grant of £2,000.00 It is a cross boundary application with 39% of the membership being from Central South. The Committee is asked whether it would wish to support in principle an award of up to £780.00 (being the cross boundary portion) subject to the receipt of a satisfactory assessment with payment of the grant being delegated to the Head of Democratic Services in consultation with the Chair and Vice Chair.

2.4 Young People

2.4.1 Youth for Lourdes (CG 4942) - The total project costs are £28,992.00 with a community grants of £2,416.00 sought in respect of a trip. It is a cross boundary application with 25% of the membership being from Central South. The Committee is asked whether it would wish to support the application in principle up to £604.00 (being the relevant cross boundary portion) subject to receipt of a satisfactory assessment with payment of grant being delegated to the Head of Democratic Services in consultation with the Chair and Vice Chair.

3. COMMUNITY GRANTS TO LOCAL ORGANISATIONS 2009/2010 - TOWNHOLM BOWLING CLUB (CG 4575) - The Central North and Central South Local Grants Committees at meetings held on 31 March 2010, considered a grant for the refurbishment of the bowls house changing area. The total cost of the project was £29,500. It was agreed to award Townholm Bowling Club up to £1,500 in principle, subject to a condition that the balance of funding be in place prior to any funding being released. The organisation has been contacted periodically regarding the balance of the funding, however, to date no information has been received. The organisation has now been advised that should the information not be received by the 24 May 2011, the Committee will consider terminating the application due to the fact that monies cannot be ringfenced indefinitely. It should be noted that the group would be able to re-apply for funding at a later date should they secure the other funding required.
