- TORs provide a transport context for CPP Boards, Sub-groups and SOAs

- TOR transport priorities for 2010 will inform SPT's Capital Programme for 2011/12

- 8 transport priorities have been identified in consultation with EAC
- Delivery involves a variety of Partners, any of whom may lead
- The ability to deliver these priorities will be constrained by the current economic climate.

- Development of Park and Ride facilities at Kilmarnock (including bus-based Park and Ride), Kilmaurs, Dunlop and Stewarton rail stations
- Enhancing the strategic road network in East Ayrshire
- Develop proposals for a rail station at Mauchline
- Improve transport connections for regeneration areas

- Assist EAC to develop and implement proposals for decriminalised parking enforcement
- Improvements to transport in rural areas
- Promote sustainable/active travel in East Ayrshire
- Improve access to health care facilities in East Ayrshire and across the west of Scotland
