**APPOINTMENTS TO CoSLA COMMUNITY SAFETY EXECUTIVE GROUP**

**Report by Chief Executive**

**1. PURPOSE OF REPORT**

- 1.1** To seek a nomination for appointment to the recently established CoSLA Community Safety Executive Group.

**2. BACKGROUND**

- 2.1** At the Convention meeting on 27 June 2008, CoSLA agreed to establish a Community Safety Executive Group to deal with the following areas that are currently covered by the Community Wellbeing and Safety Executive Group.

- Police
- Fire
- Community Justice

- 2.2** CoSLA has indicated the new Executive Group will be established on a pilot basis initially and that there will be an opportunity to discuss the role, remit and representation of the Group at its first meeting which is scheduled to take place on Monday 6 October 2008.

- 2.3** For the information of Members, the Council's appointments to the other CoSLA Executive Groups are noted in the table below. These were agreed at the meeting of the Council's Emergency Powers Committee on 7 August 2007, with the exception of the appointment to the Strategic Human Resources Executive Group, which was agreed the meeting of Council on 11 October 2007.
