**COMMUNITY GRANTS TO LOCAL ORGANISATIONS
WITHIN WARDS 7 AND 8****1.1 FINANCIAL STATEMENT**

There was submitted and noted a statement dated 10 February 2010 (circulated) by the Depute Chief Executive/Executive Director of Corporate Support on the financial position in respect of Community Grants to local organisations within Wards 7 and 8 for 2009/2010.

1.2 NEW APPLICATIONS

1.2.1 Leisure, Sport & Cultural

**COMMUNITY GRANTS TO LOCAL ORGANISATIONS
WITHIN WARD 9****2.1 FINANCIAL STATEMENT**

There was submitted and noted a statement dated 11 February 2010 (circulated) by the Depute Chief Executive/Executive Director of Corporate Support on the financial position in respect of Community Grants to local organisations within Ward 9 for 2009/2010.

2.2 NEW APPLICATIONS

Having considered assessment reports by the Executive Director of Educational and Social Services (circulated and tabled respectively), it was agreed as follows, namely:-

2.2.1 Young People

Tiny Tots and Tiddlers (CG 4347) - that a grant of £606.68 be made; and

2.2.2 Older People

Patna Day Centre (CG 4505) - having heard the Administrative Officer who advised that this application was for a grant of £4,900.00, from a total cost of £9,855.00 involved in taking 45 members of the Day Centre Lunch Club on a five day break to Rhyl on 13 September 2010, it was agreed (i) that a grant of £1,619.64 be made; and (ii) to continue consideration of the balance of the recommended grant, i.e. £3,280.36, to the next meeting from the budget for financial year 2010/11.
