1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to provide, for information, details of tenders which have been accepted on behalf of the Council for the period from 6 November 2010 to 20 December 2010. The amounts shown are the actual costs of the contracts and are exclusive of professional fees.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Corporate Governance Committee at its meeting held on 8 June 2006 (Item 7, Page 2273, 03/07) and subsequently at the Council meeting on 6 December 2007 (Item 7, Page 199, 07/11) agreed to approve and adopt the revised Standing Orders relating to Contracts and Tendering, which apply to all contracts for the supply of goods and materials, for the provision of services or for the execution of works.
