They have also been advised to affiliate to the East Ayrshire Sports Council where they can apply for a start up grant of up to £200.	
The amount recommended has been reduced, taking into account the EA Sports Council start up grant they are eligible for (£200), the cost of training kit (£200) as they have received sponsorship for this and insurance and registration fees (£75), as they have been awarded a grant form the Bessie Roxburgh Bequest for these.
