1 Aims and objectives of the organisation

The objects of Annanhill Golf Club are:

- To promote and encourage the sport of golf in Kilmarnock.
- To institute and carry through annually, stroke and match play competitions for the benefit of the members of the club.

2 Purpose of the grant (including breakdown of costs)

The club will be 50 years old in 2007 and the grant would be used to help finance the celebrations and programme of events that the club will be running as part of the celebrations.

COSTS:

50th Anniversary Celebration Dinner at Park Hotel for 100 guests: £3550

3 After Dinner Speakers: £1350

2 Post Competition Buffets: £918

Trophies for 50th Anniversary Celebrations: £4075.75

TOTAL: £9893.75

In addition to this the club also added to the application at a late stage with quotes for a new cash register system. This will not be considered in this application as it does not relate to the 50th Anniversary Celebrations however the club will be advised to submit another application for this equipment.

Reason for recommendation

The recommendation has been made to support the application to meet the costs of the post competition buffets and the trophies for the celebrations. The cost of the anniversary dinner and after dinner speakers has not been recommended for funding as clubs should be expected to meet the costs of their own fundraising and celebration dinners by selling tickets and also through fundraising at the dinner. Other clubs hold sport's mans dinners and cover the costs of these themselves and often make a profit through the associated fundraising that happens. The club have substantial funds in their bank account and their annual accounts show a profit has been made over recent years which the club should put towards these costs.

The other funding has been recommended as it will benefit the membership and help raise the profile of the club through sporting competition which will develop the club further and also the sport of golf. When the club were asked for quotes for services and equipment they submitted quotes for a new cash register system and this has not been recommended for funding with this assessment as it was not part of the original application. However the club should apply for this in another application as it is something that could be considered for funding.
