<p>The 50's Club is run by the goodwill of volunteers and has a strong committee and membership. It offers a light lunch of tea and sandwiches to older members of the community on a weekly basis and guards against social isolation. The current application is supported as it helps maintain a varied and vibrant social calendar which is open to all elderly residents in the New Farm area and beyond. By offering 3 trips and a Christmas lunch the weekly work of the committee is given added value while the membership can partake actively in the social and cultural life of their community and region. The sum of £700 is recommended as it represents value for money between the group's 37 members. Also, it should be recognised that the group have contributed over 60% of all costs through good management of funds and ongoing fundraising throughout the year.</p>
