NAMING OF STREETS BY LOCAL PLANNING FORUMS - NEW DEVELOPMENTS AT MOORFIELD, KILMARNOCK

1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1** The purpose of the report is to request the Committee to consider street names for new developments at Moorfield, Kilmarnock.

2 BACKGROUND

- 2.1** The Decentralisation Sub Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee at its meeting on 4 June 1996 agreed that the naming of streets be included within the remit of Local Committees.
- 2.2** Section 97 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 gives authority to East Ayrshire Council in relation to naming of streets and the preparation of house numbers etc.
- 2.3** Prior to the election on 3 May 2007, the local member, Councillor Iain Linton and Grange Howard Community Council were both informed of the new developments at Moorfield, Kilmarnock and requested to put forward suggestions for the street names.
- 2.4** In terms of the multi-member wards, Councillors T Cook, R Keohone, I Linton and D Reid were informed of the new developments at Moorfield, Kilmarnock and requested to have a meeting to consider street names and liaise with the Community Council thereon.

- 3.1** In respect of the new developments at Moorfield, the suggestions from Councillors Cook, Keohone, Linton and Reid and Grange Howard Community Council will be confirmed at meeting.
