1. **CONSIDERATION OF SUSPENSION OF STREET TRADER'S LICENCE
NUMBER EA/ST 385 (Para 3)**

2. There was submitted a report dated 12 January 2006 (circulated) by the Executive Director of Neighbourhood Services which invited the Committee to consider the suspension of Street Trader's Licence number EA/ST 385.

It was agreed:-

- (i) to suspend Street Traders Licence number EA/ST 385 in terms of paragraph 12 of Schedule 1 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982; and
- (ii) to commence proceedings to consider, at a future meeting of the Local Government Licensing Panel, suspension of Street Trader's Licence number EA/ST 385 in terms of paragraph 11 of Schedule 1 to the Act.

CHILDREN'S PANEL ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP (Para 6)

3. There was submitted a report dated 12 January 2006 (circulated) by the Depute Chief Executive/Executive Director of Corporate Support which advised the Committee of a nomination for a Council appointee vacancy on East Ayrshire's Children's Panel Advisory Committee (CPAC) and which sought the Committee's decision in respect of an appointment to the Committee.

It was agreed:-

- (i) that Patricia Ferrie be appointed as the Council appointee until 3 years from the date of this meeting, subject to satisfactory Disclosure Scotland criminal records check; and
- (ii) that it be remitted to the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Support to advise the Scottish Executive of the Council's appointment to the CPAC.
