**1. APPLICATION NO 05/0701/LB - EAST AYRSHIRE COUNCIL ROADS AND TRANSPORTATION DIVISION: 108-114 JOHN FINNIE STREET, KILMARNOCK**

There was submitted an executive summary sheet and report dated 5 September 2005 (both circulated) by the Head of Planning, Development and Building Standards on a Listed Building application for proposed installation of wall mounted street lighting units and associated cabling at 108-114 John Finnie Street, Kilmarnock.
