ADOPTION OF REVISED PROCEDURE - TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS

1. There was submitted a report dated 14 June 2004 (circulated) by the Acting Executive Director of Corporate Support which submitted for approval revised procedures to be followed when members of the public were invited to address the Development Services Committee in support of their objections to proposed Traffic Regulation Orders.

It was agreed to approve the revised procedures as detailed within the report.

ON-STREET PARKING - KILMARNOCK TOWN CENTRE

2. There was submitted a report dated 8 June 2004 (circulated) by the Executive Director of Development and Property Services which (i) advised the Committee of those remaining objections to the proposed East Ayrshire Council (Various Roads, Kilmarnock) (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and Designated Parking Places) Order; and (ii) sought approval of the proposed Order.

The Head of Roads and Transportation introduced, and explained the terms of, the proposed Order.

No Hearing took place as the objectors were not present or represented.

Councillor Smith, seconded by Councillor Farrell, moved:-

- (i) to approve the amendment of the draft parking Order by reducing the length of the "no waiting at any time" restriction on Portland Road, Kilmarnock, as detailed within the report; and
- (ii) to approve the draft Order.

Councillor McDill, seconded by Councillor D Coffey, moved as an amendment:-

- (i) to approve the amendment of the draft parking Order by reducing the length of the "no waiting at any time" restriction on Portland Road, Kilmarnock, as detailed within the report; and
- (ii) to approve the draft Order, subject to the cost of on-street parking permits for business users in the proposed 2 hour waiting area, being reduced by 50% from the proposed levels indicated in Paragraph 2.2 of the report.

On a division by a show of hands, the motion was carried by 10 votes to 4.

Councillors Young and Kelly joined the meeting during consideration, but prior to determination of the above item.

The meeting terminated at 0915 hours.
