STREET NAMING: PROPOSED HOUSING DEVELOPMENT OFF PENNYLANDS ROAD, AUCHINLECK

Report by the Depute Chief Executive/Executive Director of Corporate Support

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1** To request the Committee to consider and determine names for two proposed new streets to be created by a housing development located off Pennylands Road, Auchinleck.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1** The Decentralisation Sub-Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee at its meeting on 4 June 1996, agreed that the naming of streets be included within the remit of Local Committees.
- 2.2** Section 97 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 gives authority to East Ayrshire Council in relation to naming of streets and the preparation of house numbers etc.
- 2.3** The normal practice for the naming of streets is for the local Community Council to be invited to liaise with the local Elected Member and to submit a suggestion or suggestions for consideration by the Local Committee.

3. CURRENT POSITION

- 3.1** Auchinleck Community Council, in consultation with the local Member, Councillor Neil McGhee has suggested that the new streets be named "Pennylands View" and "Darnlaw View".

4. FINANCIAL/LEGAL/POLICY IMPLICATIONS - NIL.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 5.1** It is recommended:-
- (i) that the Committee name the proposed new streets located off Pennylands Road, Auchinleck; and
 - (ii) that the Department of Development and Property Services be advised of the outcome.
