STREET NAMING: PROPOSED HOUSING DEVELOPMENT OFF FERNLEA AVENUE, MAUCHLINE

Report by the Depute Chief Executive/Executive Director of Corporate Support

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To request the Committee to consider and determine a name for a new street to be created by a private housing development located off Fernlea Avenue, Mauchline.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Decentralisation Sub-Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee at its meeting on 4 June 1996, agreed that the naming of streets be included within the remit of Local Committees.
- 2.2 Section 97 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982, gives authority to East Ayrshire Council in relation to the naming of streets and the preparation of house numbers etc.
- 2.3 The normal practice for the naming of streets is for the local Community Council to be invited to liaise with the local Elected Member and to submit a suggestion or suggestions for consideration by the Local Committee.

3. CURRENT POSITION

- 3.1 Mauchline Community Council, following consultation with Councillor Eric Jackson, local Elected Member, have suggested that the street be named "Anderson Avenue". This suggestion is in respect of a local coal merchant, William or Bill Anderson who carried out his trade in Mauchline over a considerable number of years.

4. FINANCIAL/LEGAL/POLICY IMPLICATIONS - NIL.

5. RECOMMENDATION

- 5.1 It is recommended:-
- (i) that the Committee name the proposed new street located off Fernlea Avenue, Mauchline; and
 - (ii) that the Executive Director of Development and Property Services be advised of the outcome.
