<p>A member of the public asked whether there was any weight restrictions on the bridge at Dalrymple.</p>	<p>It was agreed that John Bryson would investigate.</p>	<p>John Bryson wrote to the person in question advising that the bridge had passed a structural assessment and was not subject to a weight limit and that he was arranging for a “road narrows” sign to be erected, and the “hump back bridge” sign replaced.</p>
<p>Community Representative Mr Edward Torrance advised that on Friday 2 January 2004, no Stagecoach buses were operating between Drongan and Ayr.</p>	<p>It was agreed that a letter be sent to Stagecoach, West Scotland, asking why they had not operated between Drongan and Ayr on Friday 2 January 2004.</p>	<p>Letter sent to Stagecoach, West Scotland 30 January 2004.</p> <p>Response received from Stagecoach 13 February 2004 advising that contractors operated on 26 December 2003 and 2 January 2004, and in this instance, Docherty of Irvine were contracted to operate between Drongan and Ayr.</p>
<p>A member of the public raised the issue of parking problems in and around Dalrymple Primary School.</p>	<p>Councillor Dinwoodie advised that she had already taken up the matter with Gerry Cummins, Road Safety Training Officer and Euan Couperwhite, Head of Resource Support and that a response was awaited.</p>	<p>N/A</p>
