**RECRUITMENT OF COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVES 2004/2005**

**1. PURPOSE OF REPORT**

- 1.1** To advise the Local Committee on the outcome of the recruitment of Community Representatives and Substitutes to serve on the Doon Valley Local Committee for the period commencing 1 April 2004 to 31 March 2005.

**2. BACKGROUND**

- 2.1** The Council's Decentralisation Scheme makes provision for Local Committees to involve the local community in the decision-making process by inviting appropriate local organisations to nominate up to 10 Representatives to serve on the Local Committee as Community Representatives, together with Named Substitutes.
- 2.2** The Doon Valley Local Committee at the meeting held on 27 January 2004, agreed that Community Representatives would liaise with their Community Organisations on the submission of nominations for Community Representation (Community Representatives and Named Substitutes) on the Doon Valley Local Committee for the period of one year commencing 1 April 2004 to 31 March 2005.

- 3.1** Community Organisations have submitted nominations for Community Representatives and Named Substitutes as detailed in the Appendix to this report.
- 3.2** Patna Community Council have confirmed that at their meeting held on 29 February 2004 it was agreed to dissolve the Community Council
