NAMING OF STREETS BY LOCAL COMMITTEES - PROPOSED NEW HOUSING DEVELOPMENT AT HIGH BARBETH FARM, DRONGAN

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To request the Committee to consider a name for a street within a proposed new housing development at High Barbeth Farm, Drongan.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Decentralisation Sub-Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee at its meeting on 4 June 1996 agreed that the naming of streets be included within the remit of Local Committees.
- 2.2 Section 97 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 gives authority to East Ayrshire Council in relation to naming of streets and the preparation of house numbers etc.
- 2.3 The Local Member, Councillor Tommy Farrell, and Drongan, Rankinston and Stair Community Council, have been informed of the development and requested to put forward suggestions on the name of the street to this Committee.

3. CURRENT POSITION

- 3.1 Drongan, Rankinston and Stair Community Council have suggested the street be called Henry's Place.
- 3.2 Councillor Farrell has been advised of the suggestion from Drongan, Rankinston and Stair Community Council and has no objections to these.

5. RECOMMENDATION

- 5.1 It is recommended:-
- (i) that the Local Committee name the street within the proposed new housing development at High Barbeth Farm, Drongan;
 - (ii) that the Department of Development and Property Services be advised accordingly; and

(iii) otherwise to note the content of the report.
