<p>Community Representative Mr Edward Torrance advised that a response had been received from SPT in relation to the issue he raised at the last Doon Valley Local Committee, and that although he accepted that Docherty's of Irvine were contracted during the festive season, this was never properly advertised.</p>	<p>It was agreed to write to SPT, to request that the Docherty's service be more widely advertised.</p>	<p>Letter sent to SPT on 26 March 2004.</p> <p>Stagecoach advised that SPT should be contracted in this connection.</p> <p>Letter sent to SPT on 5 April 2004, and again on 7 May 2004.</p>
<p>Community Representative John Weir asked whether alternative traffic calming measures could be implemented in the Bellsbank area, other than the current speed bumps.</p>	<p>It was agreed to raise the issue with the Head of Roads and Transportation.</p>	<p>Memo sent to Head of Roads and Transportation on 26 March 2004.</p> <p>E-mail sent to John Bryson 4 May 2004.</p> <p>Advised 5 May that Neil Bell is investigating.</p>
