RECRUITMENT OF COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVES 2005/2006

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1** To update the Local Committee on the outcome of recruitment of Community Representatives and Substitutes to serve on the Doon Valley Local Committee for the period commencing 1 April 2005 to 31 March 2006.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1** The Council's Decentralisation Scheme makes provision for Local Committees to involve the local community in the decision-making process by inviting appropriate local organisations to nominate up to 10 representatives to serve on the Local Committee as Community Representatives, together with Named Substitutes.

- 2.2** The Doon Valley Local Committee at the meeting held on 25 January 2005, agreed that Community Representatives would liaise with their Community Organisations on the submission of nominations for Community Representation (Community Representatives and Named Substitutes) on the Doon Valley Local Committee for the period of one year commencing 1 April 2005 to 31 March 2006 for the following groups:-

- Dalmellington Community Council;
- Dalrymple Community Council;
- Drongan Community Council;
- East Ayrshire (South) Forum on Disability;
- Patna Community Council;
- Dalrymple Youth Association;
- Pupils Representative (Dalmellington/Patna/Rankinston);
- Pupils Representative (Drongan); and
- Rankinston Community Association/Rankinston Old Peoples Welfare Association.

- 3.1** Dalrymple Youth Association have now submitted a Community Representative as detailed in the Appendix to this report.
