ADDITIONAL FINANCIAL RESOURCES FOR CHILDREN'S SERVICES

Report by the Executive Director of Educational and Social Services

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1** The purpose of this report is to provide Education Committee with information about additional resources which were received into the Council on a non recurring basis for children's services.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1** On the 22 November 2006 the Scottish Executive wrote to local authorities providing additional one off funding for residential units and residential schools. In this respect East Ayrshire was allocated £44,910 for the three residential units.
- 2.2** The purpose of the additional funding is to improve the physical environment of residential units and to provide an educationally rich environment for the young people who live there.
- 2.3** In correspondence dated 22 December 2006 and subsequently 12 January 2007 the Scottish Executive allocated £328,000 of non recurring revenue to the Council. The funding, to be used to support children's services, requires to be spent by 31 March 2007.
- 2.4** The resources are to be used to support children and young people, with an emphasis on the undernoted:
- Small scale play and other equipment for providers of pre-school education including, independent sector providers and out of school care services
 - To support outcomes for children who are looked after and accommodated
 - Small scale equipment for foster/kinship carers
 - Staff training
- 2.5** The above is illustrative only of some of the uses to which the money should be put
- 2.6** At Education Committee of the 30 January 2007 a report was presented regarding additional resources for schools and early years establishments.

3. PROPOSED ALLOCATION

3.1 In relation to residential units the funding has been used to improve the units to ensure a more educationally rich environment both internally and externally.

3.2 Funding in respect of the £328,000 has been allocated across children and family services, early education and childcare and children with additional support needs in line with the guidance issued by the Scottish Executive.

4. LEGAL FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

4.1 The additional revenue expenditure of £328,000 has been fully supported by Scottish Executive grant.
