<p>Community Representative Isobel Loudon reported that the street name sign at Hemphill, Moscow was down.</p>	<p>Report to be passed to Tech Services.</p>	<p>New street sign ordered December 2005 for erection within 4 weeks – Sign now in place.</p>
<p>Community Representative Steven Brown reported the numerous occasions this year when the street crossing in Main Street, Newmilns had been disabled by various contractors, leaving nowhere to cross safely as the temporary lights provided were not practical.</p>	<p>It was agreed to report this matter to the Head of Roads and Transportation.</p>	<p>Head of Roads and Transportation has advised that ramps will be provided if necessary to assist wheelchair users etc when temporary lights in place.</p>
<p>Community Representative Steve Brown reported that the new bus shelter in Newmilns was only 9 inches from the kerb and was not safe. Furthermore the position of the shelter meant it was difficult for prams, motorised scooters etc to pass.</p>	<p>It was agreed to report this matter to the Head of Roads and Transportation.</p>	<p>Head of Roads and Transportation advises the shelter affords adequate clearance from the edge of kerb. However arrangements are in place for the removal of a bollard when the old shelter is demolished, to allow wheelchairs and prams enough space to manoeuvre around any passenger waiting for a bus.</p>
