RECRUITMENT OF COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVES/NAMED SUBSTITUTES – 2004/2005

Report by the Chief Executive

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to advise the Local Committee on the progress to date in respect of the recruitment of Community Representatives/substitutes to serve on the Irvine Valley Local Committee for the period 1 April 2004 to 31 March 2005.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Council's Decentralisation Scheme makes provision for Local Committees to involve the Local Community in their decision making process by inviting appropriate local organisations to nominate up to 10 Representatives to serve on the Local Committee as Community Representatives, together with named substitutes.
- 2.2 The Irvine Valley Local Committee at its meeting held on 4 February 2004 agreed that the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources make such arrangements as necessary to facilitate the submission of new nominations for Community Representatives and named substitutes for the Local Committee.
- 2.3 At the last meeting of the Local Committee on 31 March the Committee received and approved several nominations in respect of Community Representatives/named substitutes (Appendix 1).
