<p>Community Representative Isobel Loudon referred to the refusal of the Lottery funding application by the Community Association for a play park in Moscow and requested that the play park in the village be reinstated by East Ayrshire Council.</p>	<p>It was agreed to request that the Executive Director of Neighbourhood Services liaise directly with the Community Association on this matter.</p>	<p>Head of Leisure Services wrote to Mrs Loudon on 19 April advising that the Council intends to provide new junior play equipment at the play park in Moscow however no timescale had been agreed for installation.</p>
<p>Named Substitute Gerry Cassidy raised an issue in relation to responsibilities for dumped household goods in Main Street, Newmilns.</p>	<p>Having heard the powers which were open to the Council in such circumstances, outlined by the Vice-Chair, it was agreed that once Mr Cassidy had obtained the exact address he would take this matter up with the local Councillor, Councillor Wilson.</p>	<p>Councillor Wilson arranged for uplift of rubbish in Loudoun Road.</p>
<p>Community Representative Frank Dawson enquired about the possibility of road improvements to Catherine Drive, Galston to assist buses (difficulties negotiating the route due to parked cars).</p>	<p>It was agreed to pass this matter on to the Head of Roads and Transportation for investigation and response direct to Mr Dawson.</p>	<p>Under consideration by Roads Section. Response awaited.</p>
<p>Community Representative Isobel Loudon enquired as to the timescale for the road improvements planned for the C33 route at Moscow.</p>	<p>It was agreed to pass this matter on to the Head of Roads and Transportation for investigation and response direct to Mrs Loudon.</p>	<p>Head of Roads and Transportation wrote to Mrs Loudon on 18 April advising schedule of works to commence May. The actual timing of the treatment to the C33 would be dependent on available resources however, Mrs Loudon's</p>

		concerns re carriageway condition would be considered when preparing the programme.
