### **NAMING OF STREETS BY LOCAL COMMITTEES - DEVELOPMENT OFF JAMIESON ROAD, DARVEL**

#### **Report by the Acting Executive Director of Corporate Support**

#### **1. PURPOSE OF REPORT**

- 1.1 To request the Committee to consider a street name for a new development off Jamieson Road, Darvel.

#### **2. BACKGROUND**

- 2.1 The Decentralisation Sub-Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee, at its meeting on 4 June 1996, agreed that naming of streets be included within the remit of Local Committees.
- 2.2 Section 97 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 gives authority to East Ayrshire Council in relation to naming of streets and the preparation of house numbers etc.
- 2.3 The Local Member, Councillor Robert McDill, and Darvel and District Community Council have been informed of the development and requested to put forward suggestions on the name of the street to this Committee.

#### **3. CURRENT POSITION**

- 3.1 The Local Member, Councillor Robert McDill, and Darvel and District Community Council have suggested that the new street be named Clark Court.
