NAMING OF STREETS BY LOCAL COMMITTEES – DEVELOPMENT OFF UNION STREET, NEWMILNS

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is (i) to request the Committee to consider a street name for a new development off Union Street, Newmilns.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Decentralisation Sub-Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee, at its meeting on 4 June 1996 agreed that the naming of streets be included within the remit of Local Committees.
- 2.2 Section 97 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 gives authority to East Ayrshire Council in relation to naming of streets and the preparation of house numbers etc.
- 2.3 The Local Member, Councillor Harry Wilson, and Newmilns and Greenholm Community Council, have been informed of the development and requested to put forward suggestions on the name of the street to this Committee.

3. CURRENT POSITION

- 3.1 The Local Member, Councillor Harry Wilson, and Newmilns and Greenholm Community Council have suggested that the new street be named "Cochrane Place".

5. RECOMMENDATION

- 5.1 It is recommended:-
- (i) that the Local Committee name the street within the new development off Union Street, Newmilns;
 - (ii) that the department of Development and Property Services be advised accordingly; and
