#### **1. PURPOSE OF REPORT**

- 1.1 To request the Committee to consider a name for a new development at Craig House, Crosshouse.

#### **2. BACKGROUND**

- 2.1 The Decentralisation Sub-Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee, at its meeting on 4 June 1996, agreed that the naming of streets be included within the remit of Local Committees.
- 2.2 Section 97 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 gives authority to East Ayrshire Council in relation to naming of streets and the preparation of house numbers etc.
- 2.3 The Local Member, Councillor Brian Reeves, and Crosshouse Community Council, have been informed of the development and requested to put forward suggestions on the name for the street to this Committee.

- 3.1 Crosshouse Community Council, in consultation with Councillor Reeves, have suggested the name Pollock-Morris Drive.
