	We have been encouraging the organisation to establish a reserve fund and the Draft Accounts prepared by the Service Manger for 2005/6 show £20,000 in a reserve governed by a reserve policy recently agreed by the management committee.

<b>Reason for recommendation</b>		
It is difficult for out of school care services to be self sustaining on fee income alone. The Scottish Executive recognises this and provides Childcare Strategy Funding to Councils to support childcare services. East Ayrshire Council allocates and distributes this funding through an agreed Funding Formula. The allocation to PEACE IN 2006 – 07 IS £40,280 which will be downloaded to the organisation in late December when the Service Level Agreement has been fully signed. This funding equates to approximately 10% of PEACES 's annual turnover. The Council is also funded by the Executive to support the upskilling of the childcare workforce and a number of PEACE staff access free qualifications and training opportunities through this.		
On the basis that Peace has access to significant financial support through the above specific funding streams whilst other community groups do not, and because there are other external sources which could possibly fund the proposal, this application is not supported.
