### **NAMING OF STREETS BY LOCAL COMMITTEES - NEW DEVELOPMENT OFF IRVINE ROAD, CROSSHOUSE**

#### **Report by the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources**

#### **1. PURPOSE OF REPORT**

- 1.1 To request that the Local Committee consider a name for a new development off Irvine Road, Crosshouse.

#### **2. BACKGROUND**

- 2.1 The Decentralisation Sub-Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee at its meeting on 4 June 1996, agreed that the naming of streets be included within the remit of Local Committees.
- 2.2 Section 97 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 gives authority to East Ayrshire Council in relation to naming of streets and the preparation of house numbers, etc.
- 2.3 The Local Member, Councillor Brian Reeves, and Crosshouse Community Council have both been informed of the development and have been requested to put forward suggestions on the name of the development to this Local Committee.

#### **3. CURRENT POSITION**

- 3.1 Crosshouse Community Council, in consultation with Councillor Reeves, has suggested the name Carmel Place.

- 5.1 It is recommended:-
- (i) that the Committee names the new development off Irvine Road, Crosshouse, Carmel Place; and
