RECRUITMENT OF COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVES 2004/2005

Report by the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To advise of the position in respect of the appointment of Community Representatives to local organisations to serve on the Kilmarnock Central Local Committee for the period from 1 April 2004 to 31 March 2005.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Kilmarnock Central Local Committee at its meeting on 20 January 2004, agreed to remit to the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources initiating the process for the submission of new nominations for Community Representatives and Named Substitutes by relevant organisations, to serve during the period from 1 April 2004 to 31 March 2005 and to make such arrangements as might be necessary to facilitate this process.
- 2.2 As Members are aware, the Local Committee agreed to retain the current community representation on Local Committees, namely:-
- (a) five members from the appropriate Community Councils;
 - (b) one member from the appropriate Elderly Forum Interest Groups;
 - (c) one member from the Disability Forum;
 - (d) one member from the Youth Forum (or equivalent);
 - (e) one member from Churches in the area; and
 - (f) one member from the Business Community.
