1	Purpose of the group	
	To train and attend all local and national gymnastics display festivals. Develop existing fitness and gymnastics ability and construct new routines to perform at the festivals. Encourage healthy eating and health promotion.

	Purchase of a safety harness (£600), 4 training mats (£2467.52), 2 crash mats (£1057.50) and video camera (£479). The equipment will be used for the development of Aquarius Classes at Crosshouse Community Centre. The object of this class is to train gymnasts who display strong potential in general gymnastics/acrobatic gymnastics. The gymnasts are from all over Ayrshire – Darvel, Newmilns, Galston, Hurlford, Onthank, Crookedholm, Patna and Crosshouse. All gymnasts will progress into the Aquarius display gymnastics team when they achieve the required level of skill/ability. Existing Aquarius Team members will also train at this time with the younger gymnasts to show what they can work towards success measured by the number of gymnasts progressing into the team and attending the British Ministrada at Liverpool in November 2005.
