RECRUITMENT OF COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVES 2005/2006

Report by the Depute Chief Executive/Executive Director of Corporate Support

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To advise of the position in respect of the appointment of Community Representatives to serve on the Kilmarnock Central Local Committee for the period from 1 April 2005 to 31 March 2006.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Kilmarnock Central Local Committee at its meeting on 18 January 2005, agreed to remit to the Depute Chief Executive/Executive Director of Corporate Support to initiate the process for the submission of new nominations for Community Representatives and Named Substitutes by relevant organisations, to serve during the period from 1 April 2005 to 31 March 2006 and to make such arrangements as might be necessary to facilitate this process.
- 2.2 As Members are aware, the Local Committee agreed to retain the current community representation on Local Committees, namely:-
- (a) five members from the appropriate Community Councils;
 - (b) one member from the appropriate Elderly Forum Interest Groups;
 - (c) one member from the Disability Forum;
 - (d) one member from the Youth Forum (or equivalent);
 - (e) one member from Churches in the area; and
 - (f) one member from the Business Community.

3. APPOINTMENTS FOR 2005/2006: CURRENT POSITION

3.1.2 Bonnyton and Woodstock Community Council have advised that at this time, the Community Council would not appoint either a Community Representative or Named Substitute to the Local Committee.

3.1.3 Kilmarnock South/Kilmarnock Northwest Elderly Forum Groups have nominated Mr Maurice Ashbridge as the Community Representative and Mrs Mary Fraser as the Named Substitute.

3.1.4 The Kilmarnock Forum on Disability has nominated Ms Linda Thomson as the Community Representative and Mr John Taylor as the Named Substitute.

3.1.5 Grange Academy, on behalf of schools in the area, have nominated Miss Louise Sansum as the Youth Representative. Kilmarnock Academy have nominated Beth Wilson as the Named Substitute.

3.1.6 The Fellowship of Kilmarnock Churches have nominated Mr Peter Haywood as its Community Representative. The position of Named Substitute is currently vacant.

3.1.7 The Kilmarnock Retail Trades Association has nominated Mr John Donaldson as its Community Representative and Mr John Burdoni as its Named Substitute.
