### SAFER STREETS POLICING REPORT 'U' DIVISION

#### 1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To advise Members of the nature and results of policing issues, operations and localised crime figures the preceding period.

#### 2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Members previously agreed to make “Safer Streets” a standing item on the Committee’s agenda. Community Safety is the central theme that guides all policing in East Ayrshire.
- 2.2.1 This report gives a general overview of crime in the Local Committee area. Community Constables will continue to report to their respective Community Councils with more detailed information, specific to that area. Disorder offences, defined by the Scottish Executive as Breach of the Peace, Urinating in Public, Drunk and Incapable and Consumption of Alcohol in a Public Place will now be included in the report. The figure given is the sum total of these offences.

#### 3. DISCUSSION

- 3.1 **Crime Trends** (all figures relate to the Local Committee area)

April 2004 – Aug 2004	29	3	34	113	148	69

3.1.2 The number of 'supplying offences' reported to the Procurator Fiscal rose from 2 to 16.

3.1.3 Disorder offences rose from 258 in 2003 to 323 in 2004.

3.1.4 The detection rate for Group 1 – 7 crimes (all crimes and offences) is currently running at 71%.
