1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1** The purpose of the report is to request the Committee to consider a name for new development at Moorfield, Kilmarnock.

2 BACKGROUND

- 2.1** The Decentralisation Sub Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee at its meeting on 4 June 1996 agreed that the naming of streets be included within the remit of Local Committees.
- 2.2** Section 97 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 gives authority to East Ayrshire Council in relation to naming of streets and the preparation of house numbers etc.
- 2.3** The local member, Councillor Iain Linton and Grange/Howard Community Council have both been informed of the new development and have been requested to put forward suggestions for the street name to this committee.

- (a) Cambuskeith Drive;
 - (b) Ferguson Gardens; and
 - (c) Dunnottar Drive.
