As this was a cross-boundary split across five Local Committee areas, the amount credited to this Local Committee is £92.00.

- 6.2 **BUMBLEBEES UNDER 5'S GROUP** - Note that the Bumblebees Under 5's Group disbanded during 2004 and subsequently the Group's storage room at Onthank Primary was broken into and a number of items were stolen. The Chairperson of the Group has repaid the grant

of £500.00 awarded by the Kilmarnock North Local Committee in 2001/02 from the insurance settlement as it was felt that another Group within the Kilmarnock North Local Committee area could benefit from a similar grant.
