### **STREET NAMING FOR PROPOSED NEW HOUSING DEVELOPMENT ADJACENT TO ARRAN AVENUE, KILMARNOCK**

#### **Report by Depute Chief Executive/Executive Director of Corporate Support**

#### **1. PURPOSE OF REPORT**

- 1.1 To request the committee to consider and determine a new street name for a new housing development adjacent to Arran Avenue, Kilmarnock

#### **2. BACKGROUND**

- 2.1 The Decentralisation Sub-Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee at this meeting on 4 June 1996, agreed that naming of streets be included in the remit of all Local Committees.
- 2.2 Section 97 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1972, gives authority to East Ayrshire Council in relation to the naming of streets and the preparation of house numbers etc.
- 2.3 The normal practice in naming streets is for the local Community Council to be invited to liaise with the local Elected Member and submit a suggestion or suggestions for consideration by the Local Committee.

#### **3. CURRENT POSITION**

- 3.1 North West Kilmarnock Community Council have been asked to consult with Councillor Daniel Coffey, Local Elected Member to suggest a street name for the new housing development adjacent to Arran Avenue, Kilmarnock.
- 3.2 It is suggested that the new street name be called Lamlash Gardens.

#### **5. RECOMMENDATION**

- 5.1 It is recommended:-

- (1) the Committee name of new street as Lamlash Gardens; and
