1.	Charles McGowan, Community Representative considered that the decision not to involve the Thorn Terrace Better Neighbourhood Group directly in the Housing Stock Appraisal exercise should be reviewed.	Councillor McIntyre confirmed that the matter had been the subject of correspondence between the Group and the Head of Housing.	The Administrative Officer has written to the Group advising them to contact the Executive Director of Neighbourhood Services should they wish the matter reviewed.
2.	Charles McGowan, Community Representative enquired if the Local Committee could review the running of the Northwest Kilmarnock Environmental Improvements Group.	Councillor McIntyre confirmed that the Group had invited Mr McGowan to discuss his concerns. The Administrative Officer advised that the Group were independently constituted and the Local Committee had no authority to review the operation of the Group.	The Administrative Officer has written to Mr McGowan with a suggestion that he take the matter up with the Group.
3.	Beryl Graham, Community Representative raised that lighting in the car park at the Northwest Youth Centre, Kirkton Road, required attention.	Councillor McIntyre confirmed that the matter would be drawn to the attention of the appropriate Department.	The Administrative Officer has confirmed that the lights in the car park have been repaired and that lights on the side of the building will be repaired shortly.
4.	Beryl Graham, Community Representative requested an update on the Northwest Kilmarnock Neighbourhood Services Centre.	The Chair requested that the Administrative Officer liaise with the Project Lead Officer to enquire if further consultation would take place.	The Administrative Officer clarified that the Project Team intend to consult shortly on the current progress of the project.
