NAMING OF STREETS BY LOCAL COMMITTEES - NEW DEVELOPMENTS AT ALTONHILL AND NEW FARM LOCH, KILMARNOCK

1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The purpose of the report is to request the Committee to consider Street names for new developments at Altonhill and New Farm Loch, Kilmarnock.

2 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Decentralisation Sub Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee at its meeting on 4 June 1996 agreed that the naming of streets be included within the remit of Local Committees.
- 2.2 Section 97 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 gives authority to East Ayrshire Council in relation to naming of streets and the preparation of house numbers etc.
- 2.3 The local member, Councillor H Coffey and North West Kilmarnock Community Council have both been informed of the new development at Altonhill and Councillor McIntyre and New Farm Loch Community Council have both been informed of the development at New Farm Loch, both parties have been requested to put forward suggestions for the street names to this committee.

3 CURRENT POSITION

- 3.1 Councillor H Coffey has consulted with North West Kilmarnock Community Council, and has suggested;
- (a) Jura Gardens
 - (b) Tobermory Drive
 - (c) Dalmore Road
- 3.2 Councillor McIntyre having discussed the issue with New Farm Loch Community Council has suggested;
- (a) Macbeth Gardens; and
 - (b) Macbeth Way
- 3.3 New Farm Loch Community Council have suggested Matthew's Place and Hamilton Place after the two adjoining schools. They have also indicated that Councillor McIntyre's suggestions would also be acceptable, as they are in keeping with previous and surrounding names.
