The Senior Administrative Officer confirmed that Officers had not mentioned the Chairperson directly by name at the meeting or in any correspondence.	The Administrative Officer has written direct to the respondent in this regard.
2.	Billy Sullivan, Community Representative, asked if the Local Office in New Farm Loch was being earmarked for closure.	The Administrative Officer advised that the matter would be referred to the Executive Director of Neighbourhood Services for attention.	The Administrative Officer has written to the Executive Director of Neighbourhood Services and asked that a response be sent direct to respondent.

Beryl Graham, Community Representative, in relation to the closure of the Altonhill Community Centre, enquired when the local community would be consulted and if there was any possibility of the Council handing over the lease and management of the Centre to the local community.
