1.	<p>Community Representative Billy Sullivan requested a comparison of the transaction figures for the New Farm Loch Local Office for the period April 2004 – March 2005 and for the period April 2005 – December 2005 compared to other local offices within East Ayrshire. He was also concerned that the proximity to other local office facilities was not raised during any consultation with New Farm Loch Community Council.</p>	<p>Councillor McIntyre advised that the Head of Leisure Services would be requested to respond direct to the Community Representative.</p>	<p>The Head of Leisure Services responded on 5 April 2006 to the Community Representative providing the comparative usage figures for all offices for the period requested.</p> <p>He also advised that in taking its decision, the Community Services Committee considered both usage figures and the proximity of alternative service points for example alternative local office facilities are available in Kilmarnock Town Centre.</p>
