It is particularly positive to note that some of the gymnast themselves will be attending these courses, therefore ensuring the long-term sustainability of the Club. The group were advised that grants were also available through East Ayrshire Sports Council, to put coaches through Coach Education Courses and this has been taken into account with the amount recommended. The group have been advised to apply to the Sports Council to meet the cost of the rest of the project. The amount recommended also takes into account the number of members that are from outwith East Ayrshire.
