1.	Charles McGowan, Community Representative, requested a detailed breakdown of the costs for estimates for forming two footpaths at Thorn Terrace Playpark, Kilmarnock.	The Chair indicated that clarification would be sought from John Pickering, Area Manager, Housing Services and that a response would be given to the respondent.	Administrative Officer has passed the details on to John Pickering, Area Manager, Housing Services, for a response direct to the respondent.
2.	Charles McGowan, Community Representative highlighted a problem at the former Kilmarnock Infirmary site about the discarding of "sharps" and commented that this could be a potential health risk.	The Chair advised that the Administrative Officer would request that the Environmental Health Section investigate the matter and consider a clean-up of the area if appropriate.	Administrative Officer has referred the matter on to Mike Rooney, Team Leader (Pollution Control), Environmental Health and Waste Management.
3.	Charles McGowan, Community Representative, requested to be provided with contact details of a local organisation who attended the Bogus Callers Initiative launch on 15 April 2004 to provide feedback on the event.	David Johnstone, Principal Officer, Licensing and Community Safety advised that he would confirm with the local organisation that details could be released.
