STREET NAMING: PROPOSED NEW HOUSING DEVELOPMENT OFF KILMAURS ROAD, KILMARNOCK AND PROPOSED NEW HOUSING DEVELOPMENT AT ALTONHILL, KILMARNOCK

Report by the Depute Chief Executive/Executive Director of Corporate Support

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To request the Committee to consider and determine eight new street names for proposed new housing developments located off Kilmaurs Road, Kilmarnock, and at Altonhill, Kilmarnock.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Decentralisation Sub-Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee at its meeting on 4 June 1996, agreed that the naming of streets be included within the remit of the Local Committees.
- 2.2 Section 97 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982, gives authority to East Ayrshire Council in relation to the naming of streets in the preparation of house numbers etc.
- 2.3 The normal practice for the naming of streets is for the local Community Council to be invited to liaise with the local Elected Member and submit a suggestion or suggestions for consideration by the Local Committee.

3. CURRENT POSITION

- 3.1 Northwest Kilmarnock Community Council, following consultation with Councillor Daniel Coffey, local Elected Member, have suggested the following street names in relation to the two new housing developments:-
