Agnes Gallagher	<p><u>Bellfield Drive (at Bowling Club) - Condition of Road</u></p> <p>Agnes Gallagher raised concerns about the pot holes and general condition of the road outside the Bowling Club at Bellfield Drive, Kilmarnock</p>	<p>It was agreed Sharon McHarg, Administrative Officer would issue a memo to the appropriate officer requesting that the matter be investigated and the findings reported back directly to Agnes Gallagher.</p>
Provost Darnbrough	<p><u>Lainshaw Avenue, Kilmarnock</u></p> <p>Provost Darnbrough raised concerns about the condition of the Road at Lainshaw Avenue, Kilmarnock</p>	<p>It was agreed that Brian Weadon, Area Engineer Roads would look into this matter and report back directly to Provost Darnbrough.</p>
